Accommodation and Transport	Any hotel in the city centre	The campus is a 30-minute bus ride from Bodø city centre. Tickets can be purchased in the app Reis. Download it from App Store or Google Play. You can use route 1 or 2. Route 1: Leave the bus at the stop called <i>Hokkåsterrassen</i> and walk 400 meters to Campus Route 2: Leave the bus at the stop called <i>Universitetet</i> and walk 100 meters to Campus Taxi: Use the app Taxifix from App Store or Google Play From Bodø Airport you can either walk, get a taxi from the taxi stand or take bus 1 or 2 to your hotel. The hotels are close to the stops called <i>Bodø Sentrum</i> and <i>Bankgata</i>. The distance from the airport to the hotels is 1-2 kilometers.
